What's happening at Koskela depot

Excavation work at the Koskela depot next to the Kaarihalli.

September has begun at the construction site in the same way as previous months, with groundworks.

Drilling and excavation work is underway next to the Kaarihalli, and excavations are announced by sound signals. In addition to this, drilling for geothermal wells will begin on site during week 38.

Noise, dust, and vibration caused by the work phases are intermittent and occur on weekdays between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.

The work will be carried out in such a way as to cause as little disturbance to the environment as possible.
