Autumn greetings from the Koskela depot

Work is progressing on schedule at the Koskela depot construction site.

Construction at the Koskela depot is well underway, and the foundation stone for the future depot was laid on October 1, 2025, with the unveiling of a commemorative plaque that will be placed on the outer wall of the depot once it is completed.

There are many different work phases currently underway at the site. Highlights include earthworks, piling, reinforced concrete works for the foundations and wall structures, and geothermal well drilling.

A new temporary access road will be built on the Kustaa Vaasantie side of the construction site. The new access road will reduce heavy vehicle traffic on the Valtimontie side of the work site and streamline the arrival of element deliveries.

Noise, dust, and vibration caused by the work phases will be intermittent, and particularly noisy work will be carried out on weekdays between 7a.m. and 6p.m. The work will be carried out in such a way as to cause as little disturbance to the environment as possible.

We apologize for any potential noise and other disturbances from our construction site and will continue to do our best to minimize any inconvenience.
