

Neighborhood notice 24.11.2025

Greetings from the Koskela depot

Preparations are underway at the Koskela depot for upcoming element installations.

Element installation will begin at the Koskela depot in week 49, for which the necessary traffic arrangements and a temporary construction site access road on the Kustaa Vaasan tie side will be made.

The Valtimontie site access will remain in use alongside the new access, and heavy equipment will also be moving there. The new site access will be opened to keep traffic flowing and to ensure the safety of both the neighborhood and the site.

Winter brings darkness to the construction site, which means that more lights from the site will be visible in the neighborhood.

For the safety of those working on the site, it is important that the headlights, work lights, and warning lights of machines and vehicles are in working order.

Due to the noise, workers wear hearing protection, which means that lights are often the only sign of a dangerous, approaching vehicle or machine.

Currently, earthworks, foundation and base structure boarding, reinforcement and concreting, piling, and geothermal drilling are underway at the site. Geothermal drilling is being carried out with two pieces of equipment. Piling is scheduled to be completed end of January. After that, there may still be some individual piling work, but this will be announced separately.

The noise, dust, and vibration caused by the work phases are intermittent, and particularly noisy work is carried out on weekdays between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. The work will be carried out in such a way as to cause as little disturbance to the environment as possible.

We apologize for any noise and other disturbance caused by our construction site. We will do our best to minimize any inconvenience.
