## Greetings from the Koskela depot construction site

A major milestone was reached at the Koskela construction site when the depot's first rail was installed at the end of March and beginning of April. In total, 5.3 kilometers of track will be laid for the future depot.

In addition to the track installations, more and more structural elements are becoming visible in the neighborhood, and the installation of these elements will continue throughout this year. Roofing work related to the structural framework, as well as interior filling and floor finishing work, are also underway. In addition to these, earthwork and geothermal drilling are taking place outside. Pile slab work is also progressing and will be completed in April.

Geothermal drilling will cause occasional noise in the surrounding area. This is a phase of the work that requires a noise permit and will be carried out only on weekdays from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Other phases of the work are not expected to cause significant disturbance to the surrounding area.
